SPRING CLEANUP 2013



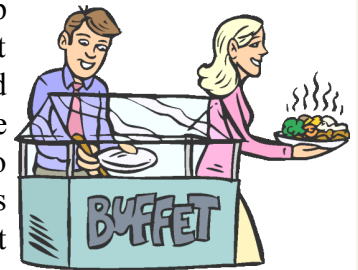
